Club Fees

Annual Membership Dues are \$15.00. Dues are to be paid at time of membership application. Memberships are valid from June to May of each year and are valid at all Club sites.

After School Shuttle Program Fees: \$35/week per child. All fees are due the week of service.

Summer Day Camp Fees: Registration Fee: \$25 (includes Membership Fee). Day Camp Fee: 1 Child \$70/week, 2 Children \$100/week, each additional Child \$20/week. Early Bird Fee: 1 Child \$30/week, 2 Children \$35/week, each additional Child \$10/week. After Care Fee: 1 Child \$20/week, 2 Children \$25/week, each additional child \$5/week. 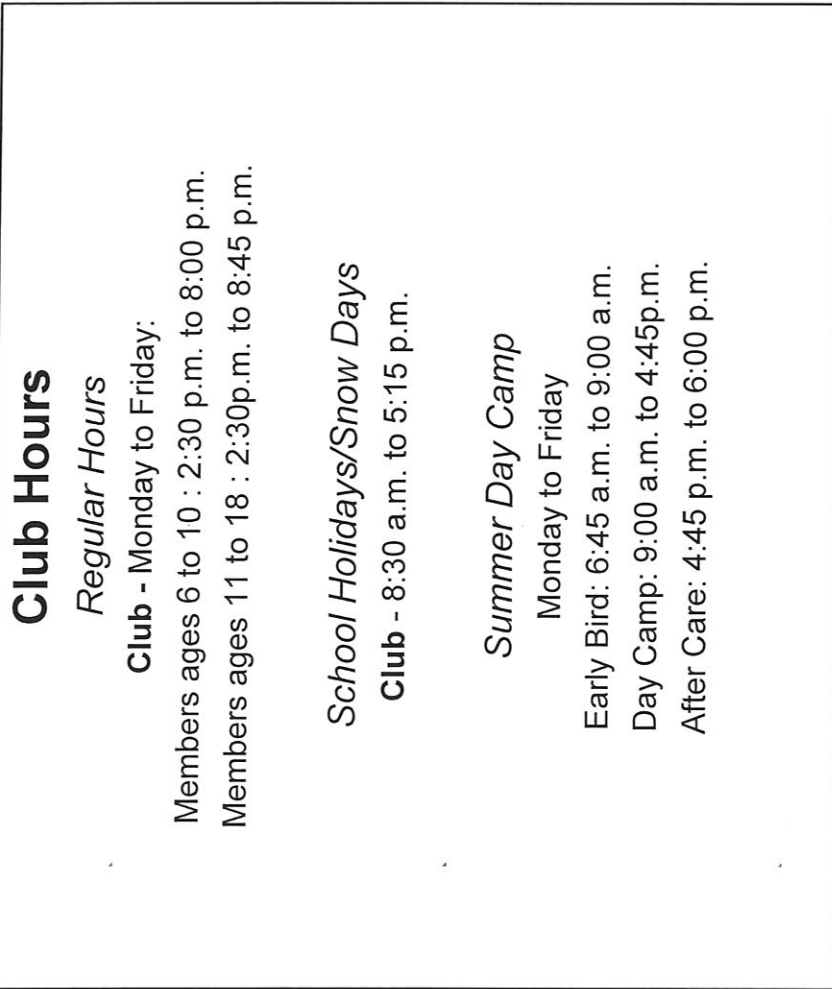
